SPECIALTY CERTIFICATION

RNAO members are part of the Canadian Nurses Association, and are eligible to save \$233.91 on initial examination fee for <u>certification in Occupational Health</u>. CNA offers certification in 20 specialties/areas of nursing practice. *Specialty Areas of Nursing Practice*. RNAO is also currently negotiating with the <u>Canadian Occupational Health Nurses Association</u> to provide group rates for this national body for all our members.

LEGAL PROTECTIONS

As a benefit of RNAO membership, you are eligible for professional liability protection from the <u>CANADIAN NURSES PROTECTIVE SOCIETY (CNPS)</u>. By adding \$64.57 to your membership to enroll in the <u>LEGAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LAP)</u>, you are eligible for legal assistance with employment related matters including wrongful dismissals and complaints to CNO; making your protection more comprehensive.

RNAO provides benefits that are designed by nurses for nurses. Depending on your needs, your membership in RNAO, LAP and IPNIG can cost under \$350/year, which is much less than what other associations charge.
